Bible Quest completes its cycle with the summer 2008 unit. The following options are available to meet your educational ministry needs:

We Believe, the Presbyterian Church (USA) 's denominational curriculum. Curriculum is for Ages 3– older youth. Information about *We Believe* is available on the Web site, www.pcusa.org/webelieve. Fall scope is *Called by God* – God loves us and calls us to worship and serve.

Bible Time Anytime, a broadly-grades curriculum, is for teaching young children (pre-k) and elementary (gradesK-5). It contains both leader and student pieces.

Each unit has thirteen lessons. Topics: God Has a Plan for Me!, Old Testament People, Friends of God (OT), Early Church, God's Covenant People, Joshua and Judges, Poets and Prophets of the OT, and good News Travels Fast.
